

Innovation to increase trials recruitment: A smart-phone App with current, comprehensive targeted trials information

BACKGROUND / OBJECTIVES

Poor recruitment to haematology clinical trials is partly attributed to difficulty in maintaining knowledge of current recruiting trials. The public & private hospitals of the Haematology Clinical Research Network, (HCRN) New South Wales (NSW), aimed to develop a smart-phone Application, (App) for rapid access to information of currently recruiting trials to increase patient referrals.

METHOD

Iterative development with end-user feedback of:

- · A smartphone/lpad/Tablet App that is free to download, simple to use and effective.
- With search filters of Disease, Location & Sponsor, the App has an easy to navigate listing of currently recruiting haematology trials in NSW and ACT
- The back-end database ensures currency of trial information, updated and managed at a local level by trial unit managers

Endpoints:

- · Rates of App usage
- · Trial referrals.

RESULTS

ClinTrial Refer launched on iTunes and Google Play in June 2013.

Usage metrics to August 2015:

- 3,365 users
- Over 24,721 sessions
- · Each use lasts an average 56 seconds
- 87% repeat users for an average 15 sessions
- · 170 users per month

RESULTS cont ...

Cross-site referrals


- · 255 patients
- Average 6 per month (range 0-18)
- · Sustained increase over previous estimates of 1.8 per month
- 33% overall increase in trial recruitment from 2012 (306 patients) to 2014 (460 patients)
- Increase in referral of patients from rural NSW and private haematologists

Staffing:

· 30% increase in trials unit staffing across NSW

Reproducibility:

The App is a template and has been replicated for nine other Australasian cancer trial networks
 – in different regions and disciplines



CONCLUSIONS

- ClinTrial Refer is a simple mobile App in the pockets of clinician researchers, trials staff and patients
- The App has increased haematologist's knowledge of the local trial portfolio and has facilitated considerable cross-site collaboration
- · There has been increased viability of trial units across the state, and a
- · Marked increase in patient access to clinical trials
